"Living with Rebels"
Text: Titus 1:10-16

If Paul is telling us the "who" of what a godly leader is like in Titus 1:8-9, in this passage he is telling us "why" we need them.

Big Idea: As Christians, *Living with Rebels* means: knowing what they are, knowing how to identify them, and knowing what to do about them.

A. What is the character of a rebel?

- 1) The heart of their motivation is pride.
- 2) The heart of all false teaching is demonic.

False teaching will always lead to death.

B. How do we identify false teachers?

- 1) Who do they say Jesus is?
- 2) What do they say is the way to have a relationship with God?
- 3) What is their authority?
- 4) What do their lives look like?

C. How should we respond?

- 1) Know the truth.
- 2) Rebuke the rebellious with love.
- 3) Rescue the lost.

Conclusion:

Although the rebellious deny the truth, they are in need of rescue.
