What "submission" DOES NOT mean:

1. Submission does not mean *always agreeing*.
2. Submission does not mean *mindlessness*.
3. Submission does not mean avoiding efforts to *change him*.
4. Submission does not mean *disobeying Christ* for him.
5. Submission does not mean a wife ignores her *spiritual growth*.
6. Submission does not mean that a wife motivated by *fear*.

What is evangelism submission?

1. Evangelism submission is designed to produce a *blessing*.
2. Evangelism submission leads with *conduct* not conversation.
3. Evangelism submission includes *respect*.
4. Evangelism submission is more *character* than *cosmetic*.
5. Evangelism submission requires *trust in God*.
6. Evangelism submission could lead to a *godly man*.

It's a Christian husband's job to:

1. Become a *student* of his wife.
2. Show her *honor*.
3. Treat her as God's *daughter*.
4. Examine his *prayer life*.
